Non Intrusive Inspection Systems (NII)

Non Intrusive Inspection Systems (NII) is a system to help CBP Officers to perform more effective and efficient inspections and screenings at ports of entry (POE). It is used to detect and prevent contraband from entering the United States, while have a minimal impact on the flow of legitimate commerce. The POEs include air, land, seaports, and US mail facilities handling international mail. All CBP NII imaging systems use X-ray and gamma-rays to permit CBP Officers to inspect merchandise and conveyances without the need for an intrusive manual search. These NII systems provide images of material enclosed in cars, trucks, railcars, sea containers, personal luggage, packages, parcels, and mail

<u>Disposition</u> TEMPORARY. Cut off at the end of the day created All NII data needed for law enforcement activities is provided to the appropriate officials and all remaining images are retained no longer than 30 days. Destroy/Delete no later than 30 days after cut off
