SINGLE FAMILY HOME MORTGAGE INSURANCE PROGRAM RECORDS

Single Family Home Mortgage Insured Case Files.

Terminated Case Binders for insured home mortgages, retired to the Washington National Records Center as part of Record Group (RG) 31.

Proposed disposition for such terminated cases: "Destroy 6 years after close of fiscal year in which terminated."

When HUD Records Disposition Schedule 20 (NARS Job No. NC1-207-79-8, approved 1-4-80) was processed, this standard was omitted because the procedures in place did not call for the screening of any terminated case files. However, our review of older records center holdings uncovered 5,271 cubic feet of terminated cases that will be eligible for immediate destruction upon approval of this request.

Specific RG-31 accessions covered by this request are: 68A402, 68A403, 68A743, 68A1130, 68A1394, 68A1562, and 68A1852, 66A2506, 66A2567, 66A2643, and 66A2674.
