The schedule was originally processed as National Archives and Records Service (NARS) Job Number NC1-207-79-11, and approved by the Archivist of the United States 1-17-80.</p> <p>Based upon experience with the Department's needs for these records, the Office of the General Counsel proposes to reduce the retention periods spelled out in item 9 as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Item 9.a.(1), from 15 to 5 years. Item 9.a.(2), from 6 to 2 years. Item 9.b.(1), from 7 to 3 years. Item 9.b.(2), from 3 to 2 years. <p>The rest of the language, as originally approved, remains unchanged.
