	<p align="center"><u>Index Card Tracking System</u></p> <p>The index cards (3x5) were prepared and used from about 1940 to 1991. They were used to track "new" employees with the department from the applicant stage to their appointment which was signified by the letter "A" Upon departure of the employee. the card was noted to show that the file had been retired to the Civilian Personnel Records Center. The index card system was replaced by an electronic database which tracked new employees. This index card system has no further reference value.
