Nominations Files in the Office of Legislative Affairs

The Assistant Attorney General for the Office of Legislative Affairs has the responsibility for the development and implementation of strategies to advance the Department's legislative initiatives and other interests relating to Congress. As such, the Office of Legislative Affairs participates in the Senate confirmation process for Department nominees, such as the Attorney General, Deputy Attorney General, Associate Attorney General, Assistant Attorneys General, Senate-confirmed heads of Divisions, United States Attorneys, and United States Marshals. The AAG for OLA is responsible for maintaining the liaison between the Department and Congress about these nominees and reviewing, coordinating and submitting the requisite paperwork for the nominees to the Senate. In support of this function, OLA maintains a body of records documenting this activity. These files are largely duplicative of the materials submitted to the Senate and are arranged alphabetically by name of nominee.

Disposition: TEMPORARY. Cut off when the nominee withdraws from consideration or when the confirmed nominee leaves the Department. Destroy three months after cutoff.
