


1.	<p><b>DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, DUPLEX-NUMERIC CASE FILES: CLASS 195 - Cigarette Labeling and Advertising Act of 1969.</b></p> <p>This classification covers correspondence and litigation concerning violations of the Cigarette Labeling and Advertising Act of 1969, which bans the advertisement of cigarettes on media of electronic communication within the jurisdiction of the FCC, including both radio and television. The Department issues statements of enforcement intention and has authority to institute injunction and criminal proceedings against violators of the act. Papers included in these files are useful for reference many years later.</p> <p><u>Disposition:</u> Transfer to WNRC one year after close of case. Destroy 20 years after close of case.</p>		WITHDRAWN
