1.	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>EQUITABLE SHARING RECORDS</u></p> <p>Under Title 21 USC 881(e), the Attorney General is authorized to dispose of criminally or civilly forfeited property by (1) retaining the property for official use; (2) transferring forfeited cash or proceeds of sale of forfeited property to any Federal, state, or local agency pursuant to the Tariff Act of 1930, Title 19 USC 1616; or (3) placing the forfeited cash or proceeds of sale of forfeited property in an appropriation called the Department of Justice Assets Forfeiture Fund.</p> <p>Records consist of Form DAG-71, Application for Transfer of Federally Forfeited Property; Form DAG-72, Decision Form for Transfer of Federally Forfeited Property; Order of Forfeiture; decision document, and correspondence.</p> <p><u>Disposition:</u> Transfer to the Washington National Records Center one year after asset case closing. Destroy six years after asset case closing.</p>
