1.	<p>The Telecommunications Services Staff provides telephone services to the Department in the Washington, DC metropolitan area with a 30,000 line switch. The switch maintains and generates call detail records, both electronic and paper. These records are used to manage the switch, for investigative purposes, and to curb telephone abuse.</p> <p><u>Call Detail Records</u> contain information about long-distance calls placed from the Department's switch. This information includes calling number, called number, duration, time of day, date, and technical information such as whether the call is "on" or "off-net".</p> <p><u>Disposition:</u> Destroy after three years, or audit by the General Accounting Office, whichever is sooner.</p> <p>→ Records for those numbers associated with e-mail transmission may be deleted or destroyed if the agency has ensured that the transmission data that is necessary for the intelligibility of the e-mail record is preserved elsewhere.</p>		<p>Language approved by DOJ Per e-mail from Marc Wolfe 5/23/95 JMR</p>
