1	<p align="center"><b><u>Support Records to the Prosecutor's Office of the International Tribunal</u></b></p> <p>In 1994, ENRD's Office of Litigation Support began work in support of the Office of the Prosecutor of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991. (This project was later expanded to include Rwanda) The litigation support effort was funded through reimbursable agreements sent by the U.S. Department of State. CACI, one of the ENRD litigation support vendors, along with GMR, an ENRD hardware/software vendor, worked closely with OLS staff. Together, all parties prepared a requirements analysis and implemented plans to provide an information system in support of the Office of the Prosecutor. The support activities were terminated in 1998 when OLS participation ended and unspent funds were returned to the Department of State.</p>
