

This file contains abstracts of testimony given before the Senate Select committee in both Executive and Pegular Sessions. Each record contains an abstract relating to only one event. Associated with that event is a table of names mentioned by the witness in his testimony relating to that event. Given an individual's name, one can tetrieve all records of his testimony or in which his name is mentioned.

This file was prepared by the staff of the Committee and turned over to us last August. We have substantially modified this file. The original file, but for the classified information in it, has been made available to the public.

This file contains abstracts of testimony given before the Grand Juries and in WSPF Office interviews, it also contains abstracts of the Kalmbach and Connalley Diaries.
