Shaheen, Jr., Counsel, Office of Professional Responsibility, established this task force on May 4, 1976, in response to a memorandum dated April 26, 1976 from the Attorney General. The memorandum requested an inquiry to determine whether the FBI investigation of the assassination of Dr. King was thorough and unbiased; and, whether there was evidence of FBI involvement in the assassination and if so did that involvement warrant criminal prosecution or other appropriate action.</p> <p>The report includes appendices composed of documents referred to in the body, interview memoranda and attorneys' work notes. The report and appendices as submitted to the Attorney General are classified <u>TOP SECRET</u>.</p> <p>Volume: 6 cubic feet</p> <p>Disposition: Transfer immediately to Washington National Records Center. After 10 years, offer to NARS for permanent retention.</p>
