	<p>The Tax Division automated its Classification Locator Unit (CLU) in February 1982. This automation enabled CLU to research all incoming mail and to create new cases when necessary. When a new case is created, a docket card is generated by the computer and appended to the mail. The three-month parallel test is now complete and the manually generated record card (Form OBD-176) can be eliminated. This card was created for all cases and matters, and as a secondary cross-reference source. The computer files now contain the same information.</p> <p>Form OBD-176, Record Card.
