1.	Amend Job No. NCL-60-78-1, Records of the Criminal Division, by adding to Part II a new item no. 108, with text as follows: Class - 185 Forfeitures (Criminal Violations). Files under this classification involve forfeitures, including petitions for the remission or mitigation of forfeiture, arising under the Controlled Substances Act, 21 U.S.C. 801 et. seq.; the Contraband Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. 781; smuggling and unlawful importation under the Customs laws, 18 U.S.C. 545 as made applicable by 19 U.S.C. 1595a; the unlawful possession of firearms, 18 U.S.C. 924(d) as made applicable by 26 U.S.C. 7301; the possession of counterfeit paraphernalia, 18 U.S.C. 492; violations of the Munitions Control Act, 22 U.S.C. 401; the Trading With the Enemy Act, 50 App. U.S.C. 5(b); Neutrality laws, 18 U.S.C. 962 et. seq.; the Foreign Assets Control Regulations, 31 CFR 500; the Cuban Assets Control Regulations, 31 CFR 515; and the Rhodesian Sanctions, 31 CFR 530. <u>DISPOSITION:</u> Destroy 10 years after close of case. (NOTE: This class was inadvertently omitted from the original submission of NCL-60-78-1, although DJ 185 was created in December 1975.)		WITHDRAWN
