	Records Provided to the Joint Intelligence Committee Inquiry (JICI) On February 14, 2002, the House of Representatives Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence and the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence began a joint inquiry to address questions related to the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks. The inquiry delved into what the intelligence community knew before 9/11 about the scope and nature of any possible terrorist attacks, what was done with the information, and how the intelligence community interacted with each other and other local, state, and Federal agencies. This review became known as the Joint Intelligence Committee Inquiry or the "JICI review." In December 2002, the JICI released its final report entitled "Joint Inquiry into Intelligence Community Activities before and after the Terrorist Attacks of September 11, 2001."

	<p>At the behest of the JICI, the FBI compiled copies of records from case files including link analysis charts, interview notes, electronic communications, and other related records. JICI was allowed to review unredacted versions of these documents at the FBI. Those documents that required additional review were redacted, copied, and provided to the JICI team.</p> <p>The existing collection of documents is divided into two sets: the most complete set includes copies of un-redacted versions of all documents that JICI asked to see, while the other smaller set contains redacted copies of all documents that were provided to the JICI. The entire collection has been inventoried and Bates stamped. In addition, the redacted copies that were provided to JICI were also scanned. A database was also created to track requests submitted by JICI members; however, due to software migration issues, the database is no longer readable.</p> <p>All the documents in this collection are duplicates of records found in official FBI case files.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Un-redacted and redacted hard copy documents: Disposition: PERMANENT. Transfer to NARA when the newest record is twenty-five years old (in 2026). b. Scanned versions: Disposition: PERMANENT. Transfer to NARA when the newest record is twenty-five years old (in 2026). c. Indices listing all documents compiled for and/or provided to JICI: Disposition: PERMANENT. Transfer to NARA with the related records. d. Database used to track JICI requests: Disposition: Temporary. DELETE immediately.
