	Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA) Acquired Information (U) Pursuant to the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA), as amended, 50 U.S.C. §§ 1801-1811 and 1821-1829, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) obtains information under procedures adopted by the Attorney General and approved by the FISA Court (FISC). The term "FISA-acquired information" refers to all information, communications, material, or other property that the FBI acquires from electronic surveillance or electronic physical search conducted pursuant to FISA.
