	<b>Police Training System (PTS)</b>  The PTS was used by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to track the amount of training that field police trainers gave to local police departments nationwide. The system assisted the FBI by gathering data to support statistics pertinent to the number and types of training conducted by FBI personnel through the field, by date and location. Use of this system was discontinued in 2009.		

## Police Training System (PTS)

The PTS was used by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to track the amount of training that field police trainers gave to local police departments nationwide. The system assisted the FBI by gathering data to support statistics pertinent to the number and types of training conducted by FBI personnel through the field, by date and location. The remaining data in the system is dated 2007-2009. The system was discontinued in 2009 due to lack of use.

**1. Keyed Inputs:** Information input into the system records the sponsoring agency, overall school dates, number of attendees, attendee makeup and student types, scheduling and instructor information, and subject of the training.

Disposition: See Master File

**2. Input Source Documents.** Incomplete set of hardcopy documents that had been used as source data for input to PTS.

Disposition: Destroy/delete when master file is deleted

**3. Outputs** Periodic statistical reports that documented numbers of FBI personnel involved in the field training program and school usage. *GRS 20 item 16*

Disposition: Delete/destroy when no longer needed for training program analysis or reference

**4. Master file** The database contains approximately 12,000 records providing details about training conducted by FBI personnel to local police departments, 2007-2009.

Disposition: TEMPORARY Delete upon approval of disposition schedule, or October 2010, whichever is later

**5. System Documentation** System and file specifications, codebooks, record layouts, user guides, output specifications, and final reports (regardless of medium), organized by participating field office. *GRS 20 item 11*

Disposition: Destroy/delete when master file is deleted
