Analytic Tools Platform of Investigative and Intelligence Data

This analysis database is a tool suite that supports collaborative link, temporal, and geospatial analysis of textual and structured data collections. The application supports such analysis while ensuring information security through fine-grained role-based access controls and detailed audit logging. The database also supports collaboration and information sharing among analysts and investigators across the enterprise as it automatically alerts the analyst/agent when their work touches on investigative or analytic work being conducted elsewhere in the enterprise. The link analysis database is intended to be used by intelligence analysts, language analysts, special agents supporting Field Intelligence Groups (FIGs) and Regional Intelligence Groups (RIGs), non-intelligence special agents, staff operations specialists, investigative operations analysts, financial analysts, surveillance specialists, and technical information specialists throughout the FBI.

- 1 **Inputs.** The Link Analysis Database accepts copies of data from FBI systems for analysis

Disposition: Disks and other transfer media can be deleted/destroyed once the copies have been fully ingested into the database. *GRS 20/2*

- 2 **Outputs.** Analyses performed on data

Disposition: Provide completed analyses back to the originating system/requestor for incorporation into the master file of that system, or for incorporation into the appropriate FBI intelligence or investigative case file, whichever is applicable. *File Incls.*

- 3 **Master File.** All copies of data loaded from various FBI systems that are used for analysis

Disposition: Delete when no longer needed for analysis, or when 30 years old, whichever is sooner

- 4 **System Documentation.** Includes system specifications, file specifications, codebooks, user guides, and output specifications

Disposition: Delete/destroy when superseded or obsolete. Delete/destroy the final set of system documentation records one year after termination of the database, or upon authorized deletion of the related Master File, in accordance with GRS 20, item 11
