FOREIGN COUNTER - INTELLIGENCE [FCI] ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE AUDIO TAPES

Audio tapes of an Electronic Surveillance [ELSUR] collected as a part of a specific FCI operation and which are of no further administrative and / or investigative value. The ELSUR was authorized in accordance with the provisions of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act [FISA] of 1978.

Authorized destruction for audio tapes relative to other FCI operations, authorized under the FISA of 1978, is set at 10 years by NARA Job Number N1-65-90-003. The current volume of audio tapes [approximately 20 cubic feet], continued accumulation of tapes [approximately 5 - 6 cubic feet per year], and security classification level the material present a storage and maintenance burden for this single FBI Field Office.

Related transcripts, extracts, and other written materials will be retained for 50 years commensurate with the NARA-approved disposition of the Case File and transferred to NARA with the case file JDF 10-12-93
