

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) requests disposal authority for an investigative file (File No. 137-11045), related indices, and other cross-reference material maintained at headquarters and field offices. According to Clara M. Glock of the FBI's Records Management Division, this disposal request derives from a Privacy Act inquiry in which the inquirer, after securing access to this file, requested its expungement. The inquirer has challenged the accuracy and relevance of the information in the file, and the FBI has determined that continued maintenance of the file could conflict with subsection (e) (5) of the Privacy Act.

On May 18, 1978, I examined the file covered by this request. It does not meet the criteria set forth in Job No. NCI-65-77-2 (still under congressional review) for permanent retention of investigative files. The file involves informant matters, and the documentation falls within the period, 1964-66.

According to Ms. Glock, the FBI informed the inquirer on December 1, 1976, of its willingness to request disposal of the file. Disposal authority for the file was not requested immediately from NARS, however, for Job No. NCI-65-77-2 contained authority to dispose of such records in response to Privacy Act requests, and the FBI hoped that Congress would review the schedule expeditiously. As neither NARS nor the FBI has yet been able to determine when the congressional review will be completed, the FBI has decided to meet the inquirer's request for expungement of the file by submitting this disposal request.

I recommend that we approve the request. Once approved, we should follow our normal procedure of forwarding a copy of the job to the Select Committee under cover of the attached letter.
