Correspondence, index cards and related material maintained at Federal Bureau of Investigation Headquarters and field offices relating to the Witness Protection and Maintenance Program which was instituted in 1970. Communications were forwarded to all field offices to identify individuals incorporated into the Program and index cards were prepared. At the request of the United States Marshals Service in September 1978, procedure of notifying field divisions of the identities of individuals in the Program was discontinued. Index and related correspondence occupy .40 cubic foot at Headquarters and 59 field divisions and the annual growth rate at Headquarters in .03 cubic foot.
