	REPLENISHMENT AGRICULTURAL WORKER (RAW) PROGRAM					
	Section 210A(c) of the Immigration & Nationality Act directs the Immigration and Naturalization Service, for each fiscal year (beginning with fiscal year 1990 and ending with fiscal year 1993), to provide for the admission or adjustment of aliens to lawful temporary resident status to meet the projected shortage, if any, of workers to perform seasonal agricultural services. The "shortage number" of aliens to be admitted or adjusted each fiscal year is determined jointly by the Secretaries of Labor and Agriculture with the Bureau of the Census from data collected during the prior fiscal year. If the determination is made that there will be no shortage of workers in any year, no Replenishment Agricultural Worker (RAW) shall be admitted or adjusted in that year unless the Emergency Procedure for Increase in Shortage number is implemented. The selection process for RAW status is in two (2) stages, Registration and Petition. Illegal aliens who could meet the requirements according to the Act were eligible to register for RAW temporary resident status from September 1, 1989 through October 31, 1989. The application period for petitioning for RAW status begins after the announcement of a shortage number.

	(A) This registration form is used to collect information on workers who claim qualifying employment in agricultural services and establish eligibility for RAW status. Aliens completing the form may be invited to petition for temporary resident status. Upon receipt, forms are assigned a unique tracking number and scanned to sort each registrant into the appropriate priority class and family preference group. The card remains in the same order as it was processed, except that requests of those aliens invited to petition for temporary resident status become a permanent part of the alien's file (A-File) and have a life cycle equaling that of the A-File. For disposition of A-Files, see schedule number NC1-85-80-5-1.		
	(B) Accompanying documentation including birth certificates, baptismal certificates, marriage licenses, etc., submitted with the requests are maintained separately. Documentation of those aliens invited to petition for temporary status become a permanent part of the alien's file (A-File) and have a life cycle equaling that of the A-File. For disposition of A-Files, see schedule number NC1-85-80-5-1.
