eRecords - Inmate Treaty Transfer System (ITTS) (Draft)

## **1. INMATE TREATY TRANSFE SYSTEM (ITTS)**

The Inmate Treaty Transfer System is a departmentalized computer tracking system developed in 1998 and is currently in use to track inmates other than US citizens entering and exiting federal prisons. ITTS is operated by the Correctional Programs Division in the Central office and maintained by the Correctional Programs Branch. The system was originally deployed using dBase and later on migrated to MS Access.

A. INPUT: Fielded information to include inmate's name, register number, nationality, judgement and commitment information, transfer updates, transfer status, date of transfer, and sentence expiration date information among other inmate-related data.

Disposition: Temporary. Destroy after data load verification.

B. OUTPUT: Printed report of specific inmate information or of series of inmates based on a common search criteria (nationality, current location, security level, etc.).

Disposition: Temporary. Destroy when no longer needed for reference purposes.

C. DATA: Fielded information to include inmate's name, register number, nationality, judgement and commitment information, transfer status, date of transfer, and sentence expiration date information among other inmate-related data.

Disposition: Temporary. Destroy /Delete 30 years after expiration of sentence.
