Non-current records in this series are housed in the Kansas City FRC as part of accession 65-A-10 and are scheduled for destruction when 30 years old ~~under~~ *under* NC1-129-77-11. This schedule, however, was never applied to these records. It is recommended that USP Leavenworth inmate central files be appraised separately from other inmate records covered by NC1-129-77-11, and rescheduled as permanent.
