Bomb Arson Tracking System (BATS)

Description of system: BATS is an incident reporting system that provides access to data on bombings, arson and the criminal misuse of explosives. The system tracks, national arson and explosives investigations reported to or investigated by ATF and has the ability to gather, retrieve, report and archive incident investigation information throughout the United States.

- **a. Master File.** BATS contain arson and explosives incident information, explosives and incendiary devises, names, vehicles and locations.
