The system contains requestor information, including type of crime; weapon information; pertinent firearms dealer information; and trace results. This system contains tables: The Multiple Sales tables records the identity of purchasers of multiple firearms in a 5-day period, along with data identifying the firearms purchased; the Interstate Theft tables identifies the location, date, and identity of firearms stolen from licensees and/or stolen while in transit; the FFL Theft tables identify the location, date, and identity of firearms stolen from Federal Firearms Licensees.
