

Verification for the Use of GRS 6.1, Email and other Electronic Messages Managed Under a Capstone Approach

NOTATING THE CHANGES: The "Summary of Changes from previous submission" field includes a drop-down list of possible changes that may have occurred since the previous submission. This field helps facilitate review of the new submission by NARA. Please select the scenario that is most appropriate. (b) PERMANENT LEGACY RECORDS ONLY.
