1.	<p>CONFIDENTIAL PRODUCER PRICE INDEX PROGRAM SCHEDULES</p> <p>Confidential pricing information is obtained monthly from sampled establishments by schedules mailed to these firms and returned to the Bureau headquarters. All reported pricing data as required are entered into computerized data bases, and, by a series of data manipulations, producer price indexes for various commodities or industries are generated.</p> <p>There are two types of schedules involved in this monthly reporting process. (1) Monthly Shuttle Schedules reported by sampled establishments and related establishment worksheets under the commodity-oriented Producer Price (former Wholesale Price) Index System.
