The Coal Mine and Metal and Nonmetal Safety and Health Administrations are tasked with directing special investigations that pertain to alleged violations of health and safety standards and discrimination complaints against individuals who report alleged violations. This series consists of investigation case files that pertain to individuals alleged to have committed willful violations or have information about willful violations, and/or information of alleged discrimination against persons having filed or made a complaint of an alleged danger, safety, or health violation.

Disposition: Retain for 1 year after the case is closed. Retire to FRC thereafter. Destroy when 15 years old.
