The OSAC website is operated and maintained by the State Department's Bureau of Diplomatic Security. Established in 2005, the current website was significantly enhanced to incorporate state of the art technology and constituent feedback. It is the focal point for the exchange of unclassified information between the U S Government and the private sector on security-related incidents and threats overseas.

a Content Records

Description Information includes Department of State Travel Warnings and Public Announcements, daily security related news articles, overseas reports on security and crime incidents, terrorist group profiles, timely analytic reports and presentations created on current vulnerability, threats, terrorist attacks, and other incidents; general crime information for cities and countries, locations and contacts at U S posts overseas, and updates on new or unusual situations. Recent expansion includes cyber threat information, critical incident reporting, and specific traveler information. The critical incident reporting section is interactive for constituents to post incidents and query the database.
