2	<p><u>SHIP CREW CARDS (Injury/Illness Data Cards) 1900-1981</u></p> <p>3" x 5" cards used in the Panama Canal cargo and passenger steamships for the purpose of recording each crew member's medical data. These records contain diagnosis, treatment, and date of injuries or illnesses suffered on board. In addition, these cards also include general information such as crew member's name, address, date of birth, height, weight, race, birthplace, and next of kin. These records are the only source of information regarding injuries and illnesses suffered by crew members while on duty.</p> <p>DISPOSITION: Make microfilm copy for reference purposes and retain in the agency until December 31, 1999, then destroy. Send original cards to the National Personnel Records Center (NPRC), St. Louis, MO. Destroy originals 60 years after transfer to NPRC.</p>
