b. Opinions and comments on legislation directly related to the operation and administration of the Panama Canal.

Accumulation: Approximately 1 cubic foot per year.

Disposition: PERMANENT. Cutoff file at the end of the particular Congress (i.e. 102nd, 103rd). Retire to the Washington National Records Center (WNRC) 2 years after cutoff. Transfer to the National Archives in 5-year blocks 15 years after cutoff. (e.g., transfer 1981-1985 block in 2001).
