They cover freight claims handled for Government employees and private companies in the former Canal Zone and the Republic of Panama. Even though the freight handling functions of the Panama Canal Commission were discontinued on October 1, 1979 due to the Panama Canal Treaty, these records continue to be of value in adjudicating claims of the Commission.
