


Loose-leaf binders of correspondence, memoranda, reports, and statistical data providing information on individual drives, financing, success, and comparisons.

- 3 Wartime Economic Analyses. 1940-45, accession #056-68A-2606, boxes 6-8.

Loose-leaf binders containing graphs, tables, surveys, and memoranda relating to the gross national product, sources of funds, and inflation as they affect the federal and domestic economic situations.

Binders and files of memoranda, tables, studies, minutes, and other reference material relating to federal wartime financing. Miscellaneous publications of Treasury Department, U.S. Department of Agriculture, and Farm Credit Administration also included.

- 6 Retirement Fund Analyses. 1926-49, accession #056-68A-2606, boxes 12-14.

Files and binders of memoranda, correspondence, valuation tables, reports, legislative proposals relating to Railroad Retirement Act, Civil Service Retirement Act, Social Security Act, and various smaller retirement funds. Provides actuarial information and analyses of proposed legislation.
