

Background:

Benefits and Services Team Tracking System (BeSTTrac) is an intranet based application which provides a centralized database for entering and monitoring the status of different employee case types (i e , Retirement, Death, Pre-retirement Estimates, Post 56 Military, Disability Determinations, Change in Retirement Plan, Deposit into Retirement Plans, Open Season Issues, FEGLI and FEHB Determinations) BeSTTrac allows for the generation and downloading of detailed and summary reports Reports are used to manage cases (what has been done and when), inform management of caseload per specialist, provide information on the number of retirements per operating division, number of cases worked to BeST site management and personnel management, timeliness of processing cases, cycle time of processing cases, and age of cases BeSTTrac supports the Agency's responsibility to administer federal benefits to IRS employees under CFR, Title 5 Administrative Personnel, Chapter 1, Parts 792, 800-899 The BeSTTrac application production and development environment hardware physically resides at the ECC-MEM. The application is installed a Dell PowerEdge server running Windows 2003 operating system and Structured Query Language 2003 Database Management System (DBMS) installed

Description:

Benefits and Services Team Tracking System (BeSTTrac) is an intranet based application which provides a centralized database for entering and monitoring the status of different employee case types (i e , Retirement, Death, Pre-retirement Estimates, Post 56 Military, Disability Determinations, Change in Retirement Plan, Deposit into Retirement Plans, Open Season Issues, FEGLI and FEHB Determinations)

A. Inputs:

Data for the Benefits and Services Team Tracking System (BeSTTrac) is extracted from the Treasury Integrated Management Information System (TIMIS) and used to populate BESTTrac employee profiles The sources of information are documents and applications submitted by employees and documents retrieved from employees Official Personnel Folder This information is entered into the BESTTrac system by Retirement Specialists or assistants or other personnel assigned to the Benefits and Services Team

Disposition: TEMPORARY Cut off upon retirement or separation of employee Destroy/Delete 75 years after cutoff.

B. System Data:

The Benefits and Services Team Tracking System (BeSTTrac) contains benefits cases opened by Benefits and Services Team personnel from 1997 to present. Case information includes Employee Name, SSN, Case/Retirement/Action Type, Dates Opened/Closed, Retirement system, Due Date, Specialist Assigned, Reviewer, Modification history and Case history

Disposition TEMPORARY Cut off upon retirement or separation of employee Destroy/Delete 75 years after cutoff

C. Outputs:

The Benefits and Services Team Tracking System (BeSTTrac) allows a user to print out the Case Information and History Screen with the option to print the Employee Profile. This information is used to populate a physical case file subject to IRS retention standards. Users may also use Business Objects Reporting system to create reports from the data to manage inventory and identify trends. The information is not shared with other systems. Reports are used within the Benefits and Services Team to manage inventory. Summary reports (with no identifying information) are used to report case closures, case open inventory, etc. to Health Care Organization (HCO) management in regular and ad hoc reports.

Disposition. TEMPORARY Delete/Destroy after 2 years or when no longer needed for administrative, investigative, legal, audit or other operational purposes after case is closed

D. Documentation

System Documentation for the Benefits and Services Team Tracking System (BeSTTrac) consists of codebooks, records layout, user guide, and other related materials.

Disposition TEMPORARY Delete/destroy when superseded or 5 years after the system is terminated, whichever is later
