Description:

The Enterprise Logistics Information Technology System (ELITE) is an integrated, web-based, real-time supply chain execution system used to receive, store, manage and distribute IRS published products out of the Distribution Center located in Bloomington, IL. ELITE is specifically used for order management, inventory management, and distribution of products via appropriate transportation methods. ELITE is comprised of the following modules: Order Management System (OMS), ELITE Assembly and Kitting Management System (AMS), Warehouse Management System (WMS), Distribution Management System (DMS), Transportation Management System (TMS), and ELITE Reporting Facility. ELITE system provides output reports to the Publishing Services Data application of the Computer Assisted Publishing (CAPS) system. ELITE is the replacement of the IRS Centralized Inventory and Distribution System (CIDS) application, which was shut down at the end of April 2006.

A. Inputs:

Inputs to the Enterprise Logistics Information Technology System (ELITE) include automated data transmitted from the Computer Assisted Publishing System (CAPS), Desktop Integration (DI), Accounts Management Services (AMS), Internal IRS IRS.GOV (IRS.GOV) and the National Institute for the Severely Handicapped (NISH) (External Trading Partner).
