## **Background:**

The Data Channel Management System (DCM) is an intranet web based system used to obtain Electronic Return Originator (ERO) information via an Internet browser. It is made available to Small Business/Self-Employed (SB/SE) and Wage and Investment (W&I) employees allowing the Internal Revenue Service staff to be more proactive in their site visits of ERO's within their new geographic jurisdictions. The system gathers data about EROs and transmitters for the purpose of monitoring their electronic filing activity. The data is accumulated under a single firm identifying number (EIN or SSN) for each identifying number. After accumulation, a scoring and stratifying algorithm is applied to each firm and a score, rank and level is determined. The system generates a snapshot of statistical data in May, August, and November of each year.

The system was designed to serve IRS e-file support, management and monitoring personnel in the field and headquarters. It is a secure system requiring an On-line Form 5081, Information System User Registration/Change Request which is used to allow access to the application.

DCM provides the necessary information about preparers and ERO within the Electronic Tax Administration (ETA) guidelines. This information helps preparers and EROs increase the volume of Electronic Filing submissions to the IRS. DCM application data is used to help taxpayers comply with their tax obligations by expanding electronic filing to W&I SPEC customers, including the low-income, Limited English Proficient (LEP), and the senior populations.

Users of DCM information generally have two reasons to research the application. The first is a need to review information about a specific firm. DCM enables users to search for specific firms within their geographic region, using the new SB/SE and W&I geographic breakdown as well as search for firm information by using an Electronic Filer Identification Number (EFIN), the Firm's EIN, the Firm's SSN (if the firm is a sole proprietorship), or a Business ZIP code or range. DCM also allows users to search for specific firms by state or by Universal Location Code (ULC). These searches allow marketing analysts to analyze large data sets within a particular jurisdiction. For example, to search for a group of SB/SE (TEC) or W&I (SPEC) firms located in a specific area or area and territory for the purpose of planning marketing strategies or developing a plan for random monitoring visits. DCM delivers large data sets based on state, area, territory or Universal Location Code (ULC). The ULC is the previous district office codes. Users are also able to apply pre-defined queries to these results.

The results of research requests are made available in two ways. They may be viewed on screen or downloaded for use in spreadsheet or database software like Microsoft Excel or Access. The download option gives users the added capability of using powerful spreadsheet and database tools to sort and analyze the data to meet program needs. The download option also contains more information than is displayed in the view option.
