Background:

The Examination Returns Control System (ERCS) is an inventory management database application used by the Small Business/Self-Employed (SB/SE) and Large Business and International Division (LB&I) for controlling and monitoring tax returns, and technical time charges for returns under examination in all areas It is a real-time system that interacts with the Audit Information Management Systems (AIMS) AIMS is the official system of record for inventory in Wage and Investment (W&I), SB/SE, LB&I, and Tax Exempt and Government Entities (TE/GE) However, AIMS does not capture time charges and it is not accessible for the type of daily or weekly reports needed at the group level to control inventory AIMS is scheduled under Job No N1-58-98-7

ERCS is used to requisition tax returns, assign returns to examiners, and change codes such as status codes, project codes, and charge time ERCS users generate either an Agent Input Document/Examiner's Time Input Document or a Tax Auditor Daily Report These ERCS-generated time reports replaced Form 4502 (obsolete) and Form 4606 (obsolete)

Examination records (taxpayer) can be requested, updated, reassigned and closed for an area ERCS allows managers to track statute information, manage inventory by group or examiner, monitor time applied, conduct workload reviews, and determine what type of cases need to be requested ERCS can be used to control work that is not controlled on the Audit Information Management System (AIMS), such as preparer penalties

ERCS supports two sub-systems the Summary Examination Time Transmission System (SETTS), and the Statistical Sampling Inventory Validation Listing (SSIVL) System

ERCS contains several security checks to ensure unauthorized users do not access programs and authorized users (identified and authenticated for access to the application via a unique eight-character login and password) are kept within the boundaries of their permissions These checks are performed automatically and silently each time a user attempts to access ERCS The user has no ability to prevent the checks
