

The form grants permission for the permittee to enter upon the vessels and other property of the United States for a specific purpose on a specific date or dates. The permit warns of the presence and hazards of asbestos dust and states that the permittee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the United States against loss, damage, claim, or liability due to personal injury, death, or property damage caused by the privilege granted by the permit.</p> <p>Transfer to a Federal Records Center, in 5 year blocks, when no longer required for current business. SUMMARY

The Maritime Administration has submitted the proposed schedule to cover a legal form used to protect the Federal government from present and future asbestos litigation. The forms are signed by parties using United States commercial shipping vessels and property which are under the authority of the Maritime Administration. A forty year retention period is requested to offer long term liability protection against all claims of asbestos injuries. The form, enclosed for review, lacks sufficient historical value to warrant archival retention. I recommend the proposed schedule be accepted as written.

RECOMMENDATION

1. APPROVED FOR DISPOSAL. The records described under all items of the schedule, except those that may be listed in blocks 2, 3, and 4 of this section, are disposable because they do not, or will not after the lapse of the period specified, have sufficient administrative, legal, research, or other value to warrant their continued preservation by the Government.
2. APPROVED FOR PERMANENT RETENTION. The records described under the following item or items have been appraised by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) and are determined to have sufficient historical or other value to warrant their continued preservation by the United States Government. The agency will offer these records to the National Archives as specified.
