## DESCRIPTION OF ITEM &amp; PROPOSED DISPOSITION

## ITEM NO.

1. FREIGHT COMMODITY STATISTICS DATABASE. These electronic records consist of Class I railroad traffic statistical information developed by the Association of American Railroads (AAR). The Class I railroads report statistical information to the AAR. The AAR, after processing the statistical information, makes available the data to the Interstate Commerce Commission (ICC) and the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA). For each Class I railroad for each year, the traffic statistics include the number of carloads and tons by commodity group of: freight originated and terminated; freight originated and delivered to another carrier; freight received and terminated; freight received and delivered to another carrier; and total freight carried. Also, total freight revenue is classified by commodity group.

INCLUSIVE DATES: 1966, 1968, and thereafter.

ARRANGEMENT STATEMENT: The file is arranged chronologically by year, thereunder alphabetically by railroad and within railroad by commodity code [Standard Transportation Commodity Code (STCC)].

STATEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS: There are no restrictions.

CURRENT VOLUME: 1 REEL

ESTIMATE OF ANNUAL ACCUMULATION: 1 REEL

DISPOSITION: PERMANENT. Cutoff annually. Transfer copy to the National Archives 11 months after the cutoff. A copy of 1966, and 1968 through 1991 files will be transferred 1 month after NARA notifies FRA of approval of the schedule.
