The National Survey of Veterans is a series of surveys aimed at delineating the characteristics of the veteran population ata single point in time. The information collected in these surveys allows the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to follow trends in the veteran population, compare veterans who use VA programs to those who do not, and provides a current resource of data for policy analyses and future program and facility planning. Among the variables in the data files are age, service period, duty status, education, health conditions and disability status, hospitalization, use of VA medical facilities and programs, medical history, insurance coverage, employment and training, income and investments, and assets and debts. The VA sponsored the National Survey of Veterans in 1977 (SOV-I), 1979 (SOV-II), 1987 (SOV-III), and 1992/3 (NSV). The first three surveys were conducted by the Bureau of the Census on behalf of the VA. The 1992/3 survey was conducted by Klemm Analysis Group, Inc. and Westat, Inc. The next National Survey of Veterans is scheduled for 2000.
