1. The Survey of Aging Veterans Data File. The Survey of Aging Veterans was conducted for the Veterans Administration (VA) by Louis Harris and Associates. The Survey of Aging Veterans was designed to provide the VA with information needed to plan for the demands of United States veterans for medical and pension benefits mainly during the decade following the study. The survey yields data on the social, economic, and health status of noninstitutional veterans aged 55 and older, their patterns of utilization of VA facilities and benefits, and future expectations regarding use of VA facilities, benefits and services. The findings in this survey were derived from 3,013 in-person interviews conducted with veterans from June - October 1983. Among the variables in this data file are age, marital status, veteran status, employment, medical conditions, functional status, activity level, health and insurance coverage, financial status, use of health care services, use of VA benefits and services, future expectations regarding such things as personal health, finances, and need for support services, and experience with and attitudes toward VA programs and benefits.
