Federal agencies may cease operations when they are established as a temporary entity, are abolished, or functions are transferred to State or Local government or private control.

Description:

Responding to growing concern that state governments seemed to be addressing the problems of drugs without sufficient comprehensive planning, the United States Congress mandated the creation of a bipartisan, presidentially-appointed commission to develop model state drug legislation. (See, Anti-Drug Abuse Amendments of 1988, Pub. L. No. 100-690, sec. 7604.) The Commission issued its report in 1993.
