Background information

The End-of-Presidential-Term web harvest of 2004 represents web content harvested between 10/14/04 and 11/19/04 using the Heritrix web harvester and a seed list of 1658 unrestricted Federal web site URLs provided by GSA (DotGov Registry) and DISA at the 2nd or deeper domain levels The web content was captured in the ARC File Format and provided to NARA in that format. It was also provided to NARA as content converted back to its native file formats (as they appeared on the web. .i e. HTML, PDF etc.)

ARC is the open source web preservation format created by Internet Archives and used as a standard format by the International Internet Preservation Consortium Each ARC file consists of a sequence of compressed web documents with a header line of metadata. The header is followed by the actual data returned by the web protocol. The main fields of the header line are the URI of the document, the timestamp of when the data were acquired and the size of the data block following the header
