Among the series in this collection are military final pay vouchers, discharge orders, enlistment registers, DD Forms 214, and clinical cover sheets. Records span the period 1917 through 1960. The volume is ca. 18,000 cubic feet.</p> <p>DISPOSITION: Permanent.
