**Background Information** 

The Interagency Guidance on Response Programs for Unauthorized Access to Customer Information and Customer Notice (Response Guidance), published March 29, 2005, describes response programs, including customer notification procedures, that a financial institution should develop and implement to address unauthorized access to or use of customer information that could result in substantial harm or inconvenience to a customer. The Response Guidance directs a financial institution to include as part of its response program procedures to notify its primary federal regulator as soon as possible when the institution becomes aware of an incident involving unauthorized access to or use of certain sensitive customer information. The Board's SR 05-23 / CA 05-10 Letter establishes the Federal Reserve's expectations for Federal Reserve-supervised financial institutions and supervisory personnel with respect to the Response Guidance. The letter directs financial institutions supervised by the Federal Reserve to promptly notify their Reserve Bank supervisory central point of contact regarding security breaches involving sensitive customer information.
