	<p><u>HISTORIC PHOTOGRAPHS PROMOTING THE USE OF ELECTRICITY</u></p> <p>This Request for Records Disposition Authority covers an accumulation of black and white photographs taken by agency photographers from 1940 to 1970, showing ways the use of electricity could benefit people living in the 7-state Tennessee Valley area.</p> <p>Home economists, agricultural engineers, and commercial and industrial engineers of TVA educated Valley residents on the effective use of electricity. Demonstrations were given in homes, schools, and industries. Some photographs show "before" and "after" scenes of street, school, and home lighting. Others depict demonstrations of electric kitchen and laundry appliances, water pumps, and dairy milkers.
