POWER ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION

Records of the Bellefonte Nuclear Plant Repowering Task Force Study

A study was conducted from November 1989 through September 1990 by Black & Veatch (B&V), under contract to TVA, to investigate the feasibility of converting the deferred Bellefonte Nuclear Plant to a fossil-fired plant. The records consist of various documents prepared by B&V during this study. It is anticipated that a decision concerning the future of the Bellefonte plant will be made within the next two years. None of these records (12 cu. ft.) was submitted to RIMS and they must be maintained by TVA until a decision is made. If a decision is made to convert to a fossil-fired plant the records will be reactivated and returned to Fossil and Hydro in Power Engineering and Construction.

DISPOSITION

Transfer to the Chattanooga Records Center. Destroy when no longer needed, not to exceed 15 years.
