1. TVA NEWSLETTER IMPACT (1978 - 1988)

This series contains information about the TVA Newsletter Impact. Impact began in December 1978 as the monthly newsletter of TVA's Division of Environmental Planning. The purpose was to provide information on the programs, progress, and plans undertaken in Environmental Planning in the interest of improving environmental quality in the Valley. Impact was published as a public service and in compliance with the National Environmental Protection Act of 1969 as amended, for employees and others interested in keeping informed about the environment of the TVA Region. When Environmental Planning was abolished in 1979, Impact continued being published as an Office of Natural Resource publication but was changed to a bimonthly publication in 1980. It became a quarterly publication in 1982. When ONR was changed to ONRED, the publication continued. The publication was discontinued in 1988.

The volume of this series is four cubic feet. The contents of these boxes consist of the master file of the Impact newsletter which includes original photo's and extra copies of each issue.
