	<p><u>Recorder Charts</u></p> <p>Recorder Charts are used to insure proper functioning of equipment necessary to substantiate safe operation of the plant. A chart will generally last about 30 days on each instrument. One inch of space on a chart is equivalent to one hours time period. The charts are filed by date and instrument number.</p> <p>These charts are considered as quality assurance records and are required by FPC to be kept 6 years except for the first year's operation which shall be maintained for the life of the plant.</p> <p>Because of volume, 334 cubic feet since May, 1975, it is recommended that these records be stored at the Federal Records Center, East Point, Georgia, in accordance with GSA Regional Bulletin FPMR 4.B.9.</p> <p>Disposition:</p> <p>(1) Recorder Charts created during the first year operation-- Life of the Plant. Transfer to the Federal Records Center when 10 years old.</p> <p>(2) Recorder Charts created after the first year operation-- Destroy when 6 years old.
