Economic Analysis and Evaluation Data of Various Geographical Areas of the TVA Valley

This data constitutes economic evaluations and analyses of various geographical areas of the TVA region. The data comprises all aspects of a given geographic area in the TVA Valley: population, employment, industrial growth, production, distribution, and the development and management of resources.

In example: Step One of a particular analysis may be to determine the manufacturing firms which are already established in an area and the raw materials they require for operation; Step Two would be to determine whether there are sufficient suppliers of the required raw materials in the surveyed area; Step Three would provide a list of manufacturing industries needed within the area to supply raw materials not already being produced.

This data would be used in the recruitment of firms to locate in the TVA area, thus providing new jobs and increasing the population and the demand for electrical power in the Valley.
